•	If your insurance company requires a referral, it is your responsibility to get one from your Primary Care Physician. If this referral is not in our office at the time of your visit, you we need to reschedule your visit or agree to pay for the visit that day.

•	Bring copies of relevant labs and x-ray reports, or have your physician fax or mail them to us. We suggest calling a day or two ahead to see if we have them in our office.
